Washington Township United Fund Academic Scholarship

Scholarship Description:

- \$1,500
- One time award
- May be used for college-related tuition, housing, transportation, and/or books and fees

Eligibility/Scholarship Criteria:

- WCHS graduating senior in the top third of the graduating class
- Academic performance during high school: Cumulative B average or higher
- Must be enrolled in an academic program at Illinois Central College (ICC) that will lead either to completion of an associate's degree or to completion of the first two years of college in preparation for transferring to a four year institution (documentation of enrollment must be provided)

Application Process:

- Written statement from the student describing:
 - 1) himself/herself as a person and as a student
 - 2) employment history, community service, and/or special accomplishments
 - 3) college/career goals over the next five years (including intended major)
 - 4) financial need/any other anticipated challenges during college
- Two letters of reference from teachers, employers, or other adult non-relatives

Submission Guidelines:

- Submit all application materials at one time to the WCHS Counseling office on or before 3:00 p.m. on Friday, April 10, 2020.
